- **PREFERRED METHOD! Consider sending your student art work as an electronic file!**

Take a photo or scan our students' art work and send it to me at the Music Center on a CD. This allows students to have a greater variety of art mediums in which to create! If you can successfully photograph or scan the art work, we will accept it for consideration. All electronic files MUST be sent as .TIFF or .JPG files. PDF files may be accepted. CDs are also due by September 19. Please do not email electronic files of art. Please include a list of students and a description of their art work with the CD. CD's will not be returned.

- **INFORMATION FOR SENDING ORIGINAL PIECES:**

Art work should be at least 8.5" by 11", but no larger than 11" by 17" and must lay flat enough to be scanned. Original art will be available to be picked up at the concert (CD's will not be returned). Art not picked up at the concert will be held for pick up for one additional week at the Music Center office before being discarded. Art will not be mailed!

### **GENERAL GUIDELINES FOR ARTWORK (both electronic and original pieces)**

- Please have students create horizontal art work, rather than vertical so that it will fit well on the projection screen.
- Use bright colors that will show up well when projected. Line drawings, light colors and art created on black paper do not project well. Markers, paints, dark colors, etc.. are best.
- A variety of themes is recommended for each class. Not all art work submitted will be able to be used. There is no limit to the number of pieces that may be submitted. Please explain to your students that an additional selection process will take place after their art work has been submitted due to the sheer number of pieces that will be submitted.
- Please include the name of the student, your school with their art work. No special tag is needed.
- We strongly encourage you to send an electronic file, if at all possible.
